Short Summary	Fabio began his project in 2010 with a parcel next to his grandparent's house and crafts his wines in their garage. While his organic vineyards are inside the Lessona DOC, his garage cantina is only a few meters outside of the legal boundary, which limits him to the Coste della Sesia appellation and makes for one of the best-priced non-Lessona, Lessona wines on the market. Lessona is composed of perhaps the most unique soil in the region, yellow and orange marine sands of volcanic origin.
