

THE SOURCE MALAT KREMSTAL



2021 RIESLING, FURTH

PRODUCER OVERVIEW

Ninth-generation winegrower, Michael Malat took the lead from his father, Gerald, at their Kremstal winery that dates to 1722. Kremstal is a climatic tug-of-war between eastern Pannonian warm winds and cold northern and western winds, and home to diverse soils on large terraces, from loess (wind-blown calcareous fine sands), gravels and various formations of limestone, mica-schist and granulite.

VINEYARD DETAILS

Vineyards for the Riesling “Furth” are on the right bank of the Danube. Planted in 1990s, the vines face northwest at 210-230m on large, gently sloped terraces. The bedrock and topsoil are composed of loess, sand, and gravel.

CELLAR NOTES

Hand harvested and gently pressed before natural fermentation in steel stainless. Aged into 4000-6000L wood barrels until spring bottling. 1st SO2 added right after pressing.
