

THE SOURCE MALAT KREMSTAL



2019 GRÜNER VELTLINER, 'GOTTSCELLE'

PRODUCER OVERVIEW

Ninth-generation winegrower, Michael Malat took the lead from his father, Gerald, at their Kremstal winery that dates to 1722. Kremstal is a climatic tug-of-war between eastern Pannonian warm winds and cold northern and western winds, and home to diverse soils on large terraces, from loess (wind-blown calcareous fine sands), gravels and various formations of limestone, mica-schist and granulite.

VINEYARD DETAILS

Ried Gottschelle 1ÖTW is on the right bank of the Danube. Planted in 1997, the vines face north/northeast at an altitude of 240m on large, flat terrace with a deep topsoil of calcareous loess with very little root contact with the granulite bedrock, a high-grade metamorphic rock.

CELLAR NOTES

Hand harvested and gently pressed before natural fermentation in old, 2500-liter wood barrels. First sulfite added after pressing.
