Dan Diephouse and Jeanne Feldkamp are Corollary. They seek out marginal sites in Oregon that are especially suited to make sparkling wine. Through their cooler climates and slower ripening, these vineyards create more delicate wines of outstanding quality. They work with gifted growers and farmers who are committed to farming sustainably—whether organically, biodynamically, or LIVE certified. All their vineyards are herbicide free. All their wines age a minimum of six months in barrel and 30 months on the lees.

Jolie-Laide Wines

Selection Massale

The goal at Selection Massale is to import the best natural wines, period. They do not work in every region or try to fulfill every need, but rather bring what they believe to be the most exciting, precise, well-made natural wines available. Their selections come from small wineries. Their vigneron work the land organically for the most part, biodynamically for some. All the wines are fermented naturally and made without cellar trickery or makeup. They favor clean, highly drinkable wines. They want their wines to be the first bottles emptied at the dinner table, but the longest remembered.

Licores Corderos, Surales Ecuador

Surales is a small hamlet in southern Ecuador, situated at approximately 4,000' in the mountains between Guayaquil and Cuenca. Remigio Cordero began his long career in the art of distillation at the age of 14. Now in his 80s, he is joined by his grandson, Ismael Cordero, on the family's organic estate. Caña Blanc is the name of the sugarcane variety farmed in this region, and this is what the family uses to make their Puro, the local name for unaged white rum. It is harvested by hand, crushed, fermented with native yeasts, and double distilled in a hand-built pot still. It is bottled at full proof.
