Selection Massale

The goal at Selection Massale is to import the best natural wines, period. They do not work in every region or try to fulfill every need, but rather bring what they believe to be the most exciting, precise, well-made natural wines available. Their selections come from small wineries. Their vigneronns work the land organically for the most part, biodynamically for some. All the wines are fermented naturally and made without cellar trickery or makeup. They favor clean, highly drinkable wines. They want their wines to be the first bottles emptied at the dinner table, but the longest remembered.

Licores Corderos, Surales Ecuador

Surales is a small hamlet in southern Ecuador, situated at approximately 4,000' in the mountains between Guayaquil and Cuenca. Remigio Cordero began his long career in the art of distillation at the age of 14. Now in his 80s, he is joined by his grandson, Ismael Cordero, on the family's organic estate. Caña Blanc is the name of the sugarcane variety farmed in this region, and this is what the family uses to make their Puro, the local name for unaged white rum. It is harvested by hand, crushed, fermented with native yeasts, and double distilled in a hand-built pot still. It is bottled at full proof.

We are proud to introduce Patrick St. Surin who is making Clairin (the traditional rum of Haiti) in the most traditional way possible: harvesting his own sugarcane or using sugarcane syrup made in-house, native yeast fermentations, and distilling in small, alembic stills, the style of which have been in use since the 1500s. In essence, these spirits express the raw, natural beauty of Haiti — terroir, if you will — in the visceral way.

Distillerie Méles Augustín Normil, Pignon, Haiti

This is distilled by Boss Méles Augustín Normil in Pignon, which is on the central plateau almost smack dab in the center of the northern part of the country. Méles, originally a master craftsman specializing in metal working and engineering while building and maintaining cane presses (Boss is the term for someone at the absolute pinnacle of their trade), began distilling on the side as a hobby. He now sells quite a bit of Clairin on the local market, having become known for the local style that Pignon is famous for which employs the use of vinasse, or dunder (for those of you familiar with the Jamaican technique). For the uninitiated, this is simply the leftover of the distillation process which is put into a vat/hole in the ground and saved to help kickstart the next fermentation. Cane syrup from nearby producers is blended with water and vinasse for fermentation in large open top vats, and then distilled in a pot still and bottled by hand at full proof. It's bold, funky, and makes an incredible daiquiri.
