Gina Giugni, a second-generation biodynamic farmer, began Lady of the Sunshine in 2017 as a personal project and an invitation to care more deeply, farm more gently, and drink with intention - a commitment to thoughtful farming, natural winemaking, and cultivating a lasting relationship with the land as an act of preservation. What started as a journey of leasing small vineyard plots over the years, Gina and her husband, Mikey, found their forever farm in 2024, the 29 acre Bassi Vineyard, located just one mile from the Pacific Ocean in the SLO Coast AVA. Bassi is now at the heart of the project, but a piece of the total 42 acres that they farm together with a deep respect for the natural rhythms of the earth.

Outward is a partnership between Natalie Siddique and Ryan Pace focused on producing small lot, site-specific wines that showcase the diversity of terroir across the Central Coast. Using organic and regenerative practices, they farm 6 acres in the San Luis Obispo Coast and Santa Ynez Valley, and source from other thoughtfully farmed sites that span the region. In the cellar, they ferment with native yeast, age in neutral oak barrels, and bottle without fining or filtration to allow for a clear picture of what each site provides naturally and to give the wines a true sense of time and place.

Scar of the Sea was established in 2012 and is owned and operated by Mikey & Gina Giugni in San Luis Obispo, CA. What began as a grassroots journey - leasing small coastal vineyard sites - has grown into a deeper relationship between farming and the land.

Mikey & Gina recently found their forever farm, the Bassi Vineyard. This coastal site, farmed using regenerative and biodynamic principles, is now their home vineyard. With it, they now steward 42 acres in total with their small, dedicated team, always listening to the rhythms of the earth and sea.
